The BSN at Georgia College & State University is an upper-division nursing degree major that students must earn placement into. This program has been in place for over 25 years and was one of the first majors offered at the university. The School of Nursing is committed to the formation of leaders in the nursing field to engage in evidence-based practice, civic participation, and lifelong learning. The program is designed to develop skills in clinical reasoning, professional nursing skills, and values dedicated to diverse populations of patients.

Once a student completes the program, the unlicensed graduate is eligible to apply for licensure as a registered professional nurse by examination (NCLEX-RN) through the Georgia Board of Nursing. Students graduating with a BSN from Georgia College will be prepared for a wide variety of settings and roles, as well as being prepared for graduate level programs.
