An established leader with an undeniable mark on the communications industry, retired Human Resources Assistant Vice President, Pamela Booker, led one of the award-winning Talent Acquisition functions at AT&T, Inc. In her role, she had responsibility for hiring talent for AT&T Retail Stores, Cricket Wireless Stores, Installation Technicians, and Call Centers across the nation. She also represented Talent Acquisition on several merger integration teams. Prior to her role as assistant vice president, she held positions as a Talent Acquisition Director, Operations Manager, Small Business Call Center Branch Manager, and Trainer. As a senior leader, she developed a reputation for excellence and industry-leading performance across operations and talent acquisition. As a result, she was recognized nationally by the Career Community Group as a 2015 Woman of Color STEM—Leader in Technology award recipient. In 2016, she was one of twenty leaders selected for the esteemed Executive Women's Leadership Experience.

Currently, Ms. Booker is the Director of Ministry Engagement at Bibb Mt. Zion Baptist Church in Macon, Georgia. She serves as a chaplain for Houston Healthcare's Volunteer Chaplaincy Program in Warner Robins, Georgia. Ms. Booker is also a consultant and provides expertise in strategic and organizational development, leadership coaching, and employee engagement.

Ms. Booker believes in providing opportunities for students to achieve their educational and career goals. She and her family fund the James J. & Irene A. Booker Endowed Scholarship at Georgia College. She also sponsors the Faith, Love, and Service Educational Scholarships at Pleasant Hill Baptist Church, in Lawrenceville and Union Grove Baptist Church in Warner Robins, Georgia. The annual scholarships were inspired as a tribute to her parents and are awarded to deserving students who are active in ministry and their local community.

Ms. Booker currently serves as President Elect of the Georgia College Alumni Association Board of Directors and as a member of the Georgia College Foundation Board. In 2019, she was inducted into the J. Whitney Bunting College of Business Hall of Fame and served as the 2019 Spring Graduate School Commencement Speaker.

Ms. Booker holds an Associate of Science degree in Business Administration from Macon State College, a Bachelor of Business Administration degree from the University of West Georgia, a Master of Public Administration degree from Georgia College, and a Diploma from the International Theological Seminary.
