A Housing Utility Worker is an individual who assists the Facilities Coordinator with various projects On Central and West Campus. A Housing Utility Worker will work an average of 15 hours per week. Primary responsibilities include moving furniture, inspecting rooms, and checking keys.

Requirements

- Must be able to lift 30 pounds
- Must be a student at Georgia College

Responsibilities

- Moves furniture in and out of student rooms
- Assembles student desk chairs
- Cleans and organizes storage closets on Central and West Campus
- Inspects student rooms for damages and ensure bed rails are in place
- Operates machinery to remove spray paint from concrete and sidewalks
- Checks keys prior to student move in
- Perform other duties as assigned
