Can't I just park in a visitor parking lot on campus?

We do not have visitor-only parking lots on campus; they are shared with other types of parking passes. The city of Milledgeville operates two-hour parking that you can park in without a pass, but you will be ticketed if you don't move your vehicle every two hours. The guest parking pass is free of charge if you wish to park on campus instead of using city parking. The shuttle will run from Lot #28 on Irwin St to the conference location on main campus. Check the parking and transportation website for more information including a map.

What is the shuttle route?

The conference shuttle will run a loop to Andalusia, LaQuinta, Hampton, Holiday Inn, Comfort Suites, Fairfield, and Irwin St., with pickup and drop-off for GCSU main campus at the Montgomery St. shuttle stop by the library. The shuttle stop and library entrance are ADA accessible.

No, there is not a regular Uber and Lyft service in Milledgeville. Welcome to country living! We recommend using the campus shuttle running on the schedule above or contacting a local taxi service.

How can I take a tour of Andalusia Farm for free as a conference attendee?

10 am, 11 am, 12 pm, 1 pm, 2 pm, 3 pm, and 4 pm on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. The hours for tours on Sunday are 2 pm, 3 pm, and 4 pm. The tour is free during the conference for conference registrants, but you'll need to show your conference nametag to get free admission. Sign up via <u>Smartsheet for Andalusia tours</u>.

Yes! You're welcome to stay as long as you wish. The Childhood Home in Savannah is open to scheduling tours on Monday for those who contact them in advance. Please note that Andalusia Farm is closed on Mondays. There will also be an open mic night at Blackbird Coffee on Sunday night from 6-8pm.

What is the ADA accessibility of the venues?

Registration and events in the Museum Education Room are on the second floor of the library, which is accessible via the Clarke Street entrance staircase or by taking the elevator from the mezzanine of the library's sliding glass door entrances. A&S Auditorium is accessible via an ADA door directly outside the venue. The ADA entrances are the first entrances you will come across when entering campus through the Montgomery Street gate (where the shuttle stop is).
