- o SON:
 - **DNP:** We are proposing an increase in the number of transferable clinical hours from an MSN program to our DNP be increased from 750 to 820.
 - Rationale: MSN students are coming in with more clinical hours. This change will allow us to accept more hours. That way we don't have to create more clinical hours for them.

- o In the April 12 meeting of the Graduate Council, a modification of the existing Web Developer Certificate was approved. This included a name change to "Applied Generative AI." Based on feedback from the USG, the name of the certificate will be entered into the system as "Generative AI and Systems Development." This has been approved by CoBT.

 - o No updates.
- College of Business & Technology
 - o Double Bobcats:
 - UG students are registering for DB 5000 level courses even when they are not in the program.
 - Kay mentioned at Graduate Coordinators meeting that they are working on coding changes.
 - Katie grimes is overriding for some students (putting DB students into the 5000 courses)
 - CoBT will start a DB Program for Logistics in the spring.
 - Executive in Residence, Barry Wolfe. He will be leading a salary negotiation panel on October 23rd, from 10-11am.
- College of Education:
 - o The graduate programs have students across the state who are still dealing with the aftermath of Hurricane Helene; some of them do not have power or internet. We are working to modify course due dates, etc. for them.
